Return to Referee Safely

To maintain the safety of all officials, the North Texas Soccer Referee program released [Return to Referee Safely](#) guidelines.

Officials Management Systems

- All grade 9, 8 and 7 are now Grassroots.
- All 2022 registration and training is being done through [North Texas Referees OMS](#) NOT GameOfficials.
- Please update your personal information as soon as possible in [North Texas Referees OMS](#).
- Choose **Member Sign In**
- Your username is your primary email address used to register previously.
- Your password is your LAST NAME in all CAPS. You will change your password when you first log in.
- All officials must have a unique email address.
- Officials 17 and under must provide a personal email address AND a parent's email address so parents can be copied on all emails.

Registering for a Recertification Course

- After you log in, change your password, and update any profile information necessary, you will proceed to Member Home Page.
- From the **I want to...** dropdown menu, choose **Register for a Clinic or Fitness Test**.
- You will see legal questions and eligible license types.
- Choose the license types for which you want to recertify and **Submit Request**.
- The next screen will ask you to **Reserve the Clinic** of the license type(s).
- Then next screen will be **Completing Your Request and Paying Fees**.
- After paying fees, you will select **Online Lessons** for the license type you want to work on.

Online Modules

- Each license type has several modules for you to complete.
- After the welcome module in each license type, officials will be directed in two modules to the [US Soccer Learning Center](#) to complete SafeSport (18 and older only) & Intro to Safety.
- It's very important that when you create an account with the [US Soccer Learning Center](#), that all the information entered is exactly the same as what is in your OMS profile.
- If any of the information differs between the Learning Center and OMS, your completion of the Learning Center modules will not be recognized by OMS and will have to be fixed by North Texas Soccer volunteers and staff.
- Once you successfully complete SafeSport and Intro to Safety for one license, you will not have to take it again as it recognized in others.
- After completing the two modules in the Learning Center, you will return to OMS to complete the remaining modules and online exam.
- You will complete a Social Media and Ethics module in each license type. Once they are completed in one module, you will not have to complete it others as it recognized in others.
- The passing score for the online exam is 80%. If you are not successful on the first attempt, review your answers before taking the exam again.
