



2021 Michigan United Soccer League Proposal for Resumption of Competition

The Michigan United Soccer League (MUSL) will begin our 42nd season this spring and, because of the continued but hopefully declining threat of Covid-19, we propose to adjust the conditions under our control to mitigate the risk of viral exposure during 2021.

The MUSL will follow the current guidelines for resumption of play under the direction of:

- The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services
- The United States Soccer Federation
- The Michigan Soccer Association

At present, based on the measures outlined in the guidelines, the MUSL will mandate that the members involved in competitions will:

- Set up on opposite sides of soccer fields wherever possible or keep benches 50' from each other if not possible.
- Substitutes at midfield will maintain social distancing.
- Players, family, and fans will number no more than 100 per game.
- When possible, players will wear masks while competing.
- Players and referees will confirm that they have not had "close contact" with anyone who has had a positive diagnosis of Covid-19.
- Players will confirm that they have not had symptoms for 14 days.
- Players with fevers will not be allowed to attend matches.

The MUSL remains committed to the health and safety of our players, managers, referees, and fans during these unprecedented times.
